

<u>Anti-Bullying Week</u>

Anti-Bullying week has seen the children writing amazing poems, designing a logo to be displayed around school and participating in worships delivered by the RRS Squad and teachers. Our children understand that bullying is threatening behaviour, both physical and verbal, which is intended and repeated. Bullying is not friends falling out or a one off incident.

School Uniform

Pupils must wear the correct uniform at all times. This includes ties, jumpers and cardigans, and footwear. Lost ties must be replaced. Children are not permitted to wear boots. If they need to wear wellington boots or warm boots to travel to school in, please ensure they have their school shoes with them to change into. Hairstyles must be smart and appropriate for school. Children should not have a shaved head or patterns cut into their hair. Long hair should be tied up. Children may wear bobbles and headbands which are subtle and support the uniform. Please also be reminded that your child must have a P.E. kit available in school at all times.
