Dear Parents/Carers,

This half term our topic is: How amazing is our Capital City?

Our topic will focus about the Kings and Queens from the past and looking at the features of London.

- Reading: we ask that you read with your child each night and make a note in their diary with regards to how they have read. To help your child develop their reading skills, we recommend that they read each book at least twice and answer any questions about what they have read to secure their understanding and comprehension. Books are changed on a Monday, Wednesday and Friday and this is completed by an adult. We ask that you write "book finished" when children complete so that we know to change.
- Every Monday your child will also bring home a set of spellings which they should complete daily. These need to be completed as on Friday we will have a spelling test on these words. Please keep your spellings in the plastic wallet and we ask that the front sheet stays with them.
- Times tables books will be sent out Monday and needs to be back for Friday.
- We have given out TT Rockstars passwords. Please use this to support your home learning. The children will be bringing home times table books and having a focus on it each year.
- PE- please ensure that your child's complete labelled PE kit is in school daily. PE will be on a Wednesday and Friday. Friday is swimming day, please remember your kit.
- No jewellery is to be worn for PE; Earrings should be removed if possible, if not they should be covered with plasters that are provided by home.
