Year 1 Newsletter: Autumn 1 2019

Dear Parents/Carers,

This half term our topic is: **Who am I?**

Our topic will focus on finding out about ourselves including parts of our body and our local area. For our Fabulous Finish will asking the children to create an 'all about me' box with three objects that are of great significance to them.

Points to remember:

- As your children are now in KS1 they need to bring in a named bottle of water.
- Spellings will be given out each Monday and will need to be handed in on the following Friday. We will have a spelling check on these words.
- Reading - we ask that you read with your child at least three times per week and make a note in their diary with regards to how they have read and whether or not they need their book changed if they have completed the book. To help your child develop their reading skills, we recommend that they read each book at least twice and answer any questions about what they have read to secure their understanding and comprehension.
- PE- please ensure that your child's complete labelled PE kit is in school daily. PE will be on a Tuesday and Thursday. No jewellery is to be worn for PE; Earrings should be removed if possible, if not they should be covered with plasters that are provided by home.

Below is a breakdown of the questions that we will be answering each week.
