Dear Parents/Carers,

Welcome back! We have loved getting to know our beautiful year 2 classes! We are very grateful for your kind messages and your support during this time.

This half term our topic is: Who lives in a Habitat like this?

Our topic will focus on thinking about Science and food chains. We will be exploring habitats and the things that make a habitat a home for animals.

- Reading: we ask that you read with your child each night. You are welcome to pop a note onto your child's portfolio to tell us how they have read. The books will be changed on a Monday and Thursday. This will allow us to have enough time for books to become safe. To help your child develop their reading skills, we recommend that they read each book at least twice and answer any questions about what they have read to secure their understanding and comprehension.
- We have given out TT Rockstars passwords. Please use this to support your home learning. The children will be bringing home times table books and having a focus on it each year.
- PE- please ensure that your child comes to school in a PE on their PE days. They will be sent home in this so that it can be washed and ready for the next session. PE will be on a Wednesday until further notice. It will then become Wednesday and Thursdays.
- No jewellery is to be worn for PE; Earrings should be removed if possible, if not they should be covered with plasters that are provided by home.
