

Remote Learning - Home School Agreement



School will...

Ensure high quality and consistent access to the National Curriculum by...

- Provide an overview of learning for the week.
- Provide a mixture of videos, live lessons, independent activities, and other relevant tasks (i.e on Dojo, Spellshed, Times Table Rockstars) to continue learning at home (as a whole class or in smaller groups).
- Respond to completed assignments/tasks through Dojo Portfolio/activities.
- Provide appropriate tasks for pupils who are on the SEND register.
- Contact pupils who have not engaged with remote learning, to check in on them and their family .
- Offer pupils the opportunity to ask for extra help if they don't understand.

Pupils will...

- Complete remote learning activities and post learning on Dojo Portfolio or Dojo activities, to the best of their ability.
- Attend all live lessons , unless they have a genuine reason that they are unable to.
- Follow the Zoom code of conduct.
- Ask for help if they need it.

Parents and Carers will...

- Ensure their child is following the daily timetable and completing their learning, as far as possible.
- Let the school know if their child has any technical issues with accessing online learning during isolation.
- Report any absences—including COVID 19 symptoms or positive test results for the child or someone within the household.
- Ensure their child only uses the online platforms for educational purposes and the links provided by school are only accessed by the intended child.
- Ensure that their child takes appropriate screen breaks throughout the day e.g. Go for a walk, Joe Wicks, Comic kids yoga etc
- Monitoring the use of their devices for access of other online materials and apps and contact school if they have any e-safety concerns.
