Dear Member of our Community,

You may well be aware that there is a significant ambition from Government to have all schools across the UK join academy trusts in the future. As a school, Priory wants to decide its own future and we feel it's important that we are approaching the academisation agenda proactively. We have considered many options and investigated a range of possibilities over a number of years. The Governing Board of the school and the leadership team put high importance on the relationships with our families and community and for that reason, we wanted to involve you in the conversation as soon as possible.

As a result, we have decided to consult with you about joining an Academy Trust that operates across Stoke-on-Trent and other areas. The Trust which are interested in joining is called St Bart's Academy Trust. Currently, they operate 19 academies in their family of schools. This offers the pupils within the Trust access to learning opportunities in environments, which no other primary school would have access to. The Trust also has an ethos which aligns with our own; they are committed to provide the best education and curriculum in all of their schools, enabling every child to realise their full potential. Their core values are PEACE (Passion, Encouragement, Ambition, Collaboration, Enjoyment) with you will recognise stand well alongside our TOGETHER values.

St. Barts Academy Trust seek to ensure its schools are firmly embedded within their communities, rather than imposing centralised brands or ways of working. Unlike many other Trusts, its schools retain a tremendous amount of autonomy, with Governors and senior leaders empowered to continue delivering a great education for your child or children, but with less of the administrative challenges we face. Our name, uniform and vision would not change.
